*9/14 - **Luke 2:10** - The angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people."

*9/21 - **Psalms 103:1** - Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.

*9/28 - **The 4th Commandment**

Honor your father and mother, that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve, and obey them, and give them love and respect.

*9/30 - **Hymn #190 v. 1 "We Now Implore God the Holy Ghost"**

We now implore God the Holy Ghost For the true faith which we need the most, That in our last moments he may befriend us And, as homeward we journey, attend us. Lord, have mercy!

*10/5 - **Galatians 4:4** - When the time had fully come, God sent his Son.

*10/7 - **Hymn #181 v.1 "Come, Oh, Come, Life-Giving Spirit"**

Come, oh, come, life-giving Spirit, God from all eternity! May your power never fail us; Dwell within us constantly. Then shall truth and life and light banish all the gloom of night.

*10/12 - **1 Peter 5:7** - Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

*10/14 - **Hymn #520 v.1 “Your Hand, O Lord, in Days of Old”**

Your hand, O Lord, in days of old was strong to heal and save; It triumphed o’er disease and death, All darkness and the grave. To you they came, the blind, the dumb, the paralyzed and lame, The lepers in their misery, The sick with fevered frame.

*10/19 - **Hymn #284 v.1 “How Precious is the Book Divine”**

How precious is the Book divine, By inspiration giv’n! Bright as a lamp its doctrines shine To guide our souls to heaven.

*10/26 - **Mark 16:16** - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

*11/2 - **Mark 16:15** - Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.

*1/4 - **1John 1:7b** - The blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

*1/11 - **The 5th Commandment** -

You shall not murder.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.

*1/13 - **Hymn #67 v.1 “What Child is This”**

What child is this who, laid to rest, On Mary’s lap is sleeping? Whom angels greet with anthems sweet while shepherds watch are keeping? This, this is Christ the King, whom shepherds guard and angels sing. Haste, haste to bring him laud, the babe, the Son of Mary!

*1/18 - **Psalm 139:14** - I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

***1/19 - Hymn #86 v.1 “The Only Son From Heaven”**

The only Son from heaven, foretold by ancient seers, By God the Father given, In human form appears. No sphere his light confining, No star so brightly shining As he, our Morning Star.

***1/25 - The 3rd Commandment -**

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it.

***2/1 - Luke 18:13 -** God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

***2/3 - Hymn #395 v.1 “Seek Where You May to Find a Way”**

Seek where you may to find a way that leads to your salvation. My heart is stilled; On Christ I build He is the one foundation. His Word is sure; His works endure. He will o’er throw my every foe; Through him I more than conquer.

***2/8 - The 1st Commandment**

You shall have no other gods.

What does this mean?

We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.

***2/10 - Hymn #280 v.1 “Thy Strong Word”**

Thy strong word did cleave the darkness; At thy speaking it was done. For created light we thank thee while thine ordered seasons run. Alleluia! Alleluia! Praise to thee who light dost send! Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia without end!

*2/15 - **Psalm 50:15** - Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.

*2/17 - **Hymn #283 v.1 “Speak, O Savior; I am Listening”**

Speak, O Savior; I am listening, As a servant to his lord. Let me show respect and honor to your holy, precious Word, that each day, my whole life through, I may serve and follow you. Let your Word e'er be my pleasure And my heart's most precious treasure.

*2/22 - **Mark 10:45** - Even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

*2/23 - **Hymn #492 v.1 “Son of God, Eternal Savior”**

Son of God, eternal Savior, Source of life and truth and grace, Word made flesh, whose birth among us, Honors all our human race, You our head, who, throned in glory, For your own will ever plead: Fill us with your love and pity; Heal our wrongs and help our need.

*3/1 - **Ephesians 2:8,9** - It is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.

*3/8 - **The 7th Commandment**

You shall not steal.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property, or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.

***3/10 - Hymn #200 v.1 “A Mighty Fortress Is Our God”**

A mighty fortress is our God, A trusty shield and weapon; He helps us free from every need that has us now o’er taken. The old evil foe Now means deadly woe; Deep guile and great might Are his dread arms in fight; On earth is not his equal.

***3/15 - The 9th Commandment**

You shall not covet your neighbor’s house.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not scheme to get our neighbor’s inheritance or house, or obtain it by a show of right, but do all we can to help him keep it.

***3/17 - Hymn #391 v.1 “God Loved the World So that He Gave”**

God loved the world so that he gave His only Son the lost to save That all who would in him believe Should everlasting life receive.

***3/22 - The 8th Commandment**

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, or give him a bad name, but defend him, speak well of him, and take his words and actions in the kindest possible way.

***3/24 - Hymn #343 v.1 “Christ is the World’s Light”**

Christ is the world’s light, Christ and none other; Born in our darkness, he became our brother. If we have seen him, we have seen the Father: Glory to God on high!

*4/5 - **John 3:16** - God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

*4/12 - **The 6th Commandment**

You shall not commit adultery.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we lead a pure and decent life in words and actions, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.

*4/13 - **Hymn #130 v.1 “Hosanna, Loud Hosanna”**

Hosanna, loud hosanna, the little children sang; Through pillared court and temple The lovely anthem rang. To Jesus, who had blessed them, Close folded to his breast, The children sang their praises, the simplest and the best.

*4/20 - **John 14:19** - Because I live, you also will live.

*4/26 - **Job 19:25a** - I know that my Redeemer lives.

*4/28 - **Hymn #165 v.1 “O Sons and Daughters of the King”**

O sons and daughters of the King, Whom heavenly hosts in glory sing, Today the grave has lost its sting! Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

*5/3 - **The 2nd Commandment**

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not use his name to curse, swear, lie, or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God’s name in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

***5/5 - Hymn #372 v.1 “I Lay My Sins on Jesus”**

I lay my sins on Jesus, the spotless Lamb of God; He bears them all and frees us From the accursed load. I bring my guilt to Jesus To wash my crimson stains White in his blood most precious Till not a spot remains.

***5/10 - 1st Article of Apostles’ Creed** - I believe in God the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

***5/12 - Hymn #375 v.1 “The King of Love My Shepherd Is”**

The King of love my shepherd is, Whose goodness fails me never; I nothing lack if I am his, And he is mine forever.

***5/17 - A portion of the 2nd Article of the Apostles’ Creed** - I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.

***5/24 - Second portion of the 2nd Article of the Apostles’ Creed** - He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

***5/31 - The 3rd Article of the Apostles’ Creed** - I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian church, the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.
