### **Memory Work**

### **Math**

The 2nd graders will have a fact test on Friday. They will be tested on +9 facts and review facts.

### **Reading**

The 1st graders are working on the following sight words: **I, my, she, her, he, his, where, what, why, when, which, and who.** They will bring home classroom library books on Tuesday. I send home classroom library books after we finish a Unit in Superkids. These books are not library books - they go with the Superkids' Units. I give a few extra days to practice reading this book. Please make sure to initial the reading slip and have your child bring it back on time. The 1st graders will also bring home their Readers on Friday to practice the story "What Can You Get With A Nickel?". The 1st graders are also working on the following sounds: **/sh/, /ch/, /tch/, /wh/, and /th/.**

The 2nd graders are working on the following word endings: **s, es, er, ed, and ing.**

### **Spelling**

The 1st graders are working on words that contain the /wh/ and /th/. **Their words are a little tricky. I would suggest to have your child go through their Spelling words a few times over the weekend.** The 2nd graders are working on words that contain an s or z sound. The Spelling test will be on Friday.

### **English**

The 1st graders will have a test on Monday. They will be tested on subject nouns, verbs, adverbs, and adjectives. The 2nd graders will have a test on Wednesday. They will be tested on classifying sentences, editing, capitalization rules, and punctuation rules.

### **Reminders**

\*I hope the students are enjoying learning about their town/city for their Social Studies project. Just a reminder that they are due by Friday, Nov. 4th. However, they can bring them in earlier if they finish them.

\*Please make sure your child is reading their library books (or 1st grade parents you can read the book to them). I would like your child to be taking Accelerated Reader tests on their books.
