News and Updates

Unfortunately, this kept me from supporting the kids in person. However, I was able to see their critique sheets afterwards, and the judges had plenty of good things to say about each kid. Religion: We studied one of my favorite stories in Christlight this week - Jesus Calms the Storm. In this story, we really get to see God's almighty power over his creation. We also got to see Jesus' almighty power on display as he healed the paralyzed man in our second lesson. In our two Faith Foundation lessons, we studied the Fifth Commandment. That means we will be studying the Sixth Commandment on Tuesday. Parents, please talk to your child about *you know what* before that time.

English: We spent the week neatly categorizing out thoughts onto paper in a manner that made reading entertaining and enjoyable. The students were given the task of creating their first five-paragraph essay.

On the grammar side of things, we also learned about clauses, subordinate conjunctions, and complex sentences.

Reading: Tuck Everlasting - I've been very pleased with the work coming in from the students over Google Classroom. It has also been easier for me to correct their assignments and enter them into the system since I can do it anytime from anywhere.

Math: The 5th graders studied problems about comparing and elapsed time. They also classified triangles, drew fractions, and then created fractions and mixed numbers on a number line. The 6th graders studied decimal place value, wrote decimal numbers as fractions, subtracted fractions and mixed numbers from whole numbers, and added and subtracted decimal numbers and whole numbers.

Social Studies: We studied school books from the Middle East and how they are very similar to ours aside from being in Arabic. We also finished our study of the Middle East and will be testing on this chapter on Monday. The Southwest Asia map test will be Tuesday.

Science: We learned about the history of genetics, and how traits are predicted. We might have even made predictions on what our own kids might look like some day..
