## News and Updates

**Meet the Student Teacher - Mr. Ryan Henning:** Hello, everyone! I am super excited to be here at Trinity! I enjoy playing piano and singing, along with theater, basketball, and eating just about anything! Feel free to ask me any questions. With my theater background, I'm not afraid to talk. God's blessings to you all!

**Religion:** Since there was no school on Friday, we had two Christlight lessons and only one Faith Foundations lesson this week. Our Christlight lessons centered around Jesus' love for every one of us. We studied his examples of this as he healed a blind man and the ten lepers. In Faith Foundations, we studied the three distinct uses of the law: mirror, curb, guide.

**English:** Mr. Henning had the opportunity to teach his first two Shurley English classes this week. In his lessons, the students practiced mixed patten sentences and making singular nouns plural.

**Reading: Island of the Blue Dolphins:** We read through chapters 8-11 and learned more about the character of Karana as she struggles to find her self all alone on an island. Will she ever make it off of the island or will she be stranded there forever?

**Math:** The 5th graders had an investigation on probability where they worked with dice and spinners to find probable outcomes. Mr. Henning also taught them mini lessons in geometry and algebra. The 6th graders had lessons on adding three or more fractions, writing mixed numbers as improper fractions, subtracting mixed numbers with regrouping, and classifying quadrilaterals.

**Social Studies:** Now that West and Central Africa have gained their Independence, they needed to figure out how to be successful on their own. This came with its challenges and they tried out many different styles of government. This lesson brought us to the end of the chapter. We will be reviewing the chapter on Monday and testing on Wednesday. The map test won't be until February 15.

**Science:** The study of space can be so captivating and also mind boggling. It was certainly all of that and then some this week as we studied the stars, galaxies and beyond. The text book comes at these lessons from an Evolutionist standpoint. If one does not believe in an Almighty Creator, one has to search for answers and make assumptions. To ensure the students at Trinity receive a well-rounded education also to prepare them for a conversation in high school or college, we studied the Big Bang Theory and its attempt to explain how the universe began.
