## News and Updates

**Play Practices:** It was the first week of after school play practices! The students finally started studying the lines they were given a month ago and told to memorize by February 27. It was a very productive week. We got lots of learning in and had fun doing it. The play is also making great strides! If your child has free time in the evening, please remind them to go over their lines.

**Religion:** This week, Jesus taught us two parables: The first was the parable of the Bags of Money. This parable taught us how God has given each of us different talents, and he wants us to use them faithfully. The second parable we studied was the parable of the Workers in the Vineyard. This parable taught us how God promises to save us by his grace, not by anything we have done. In our Faith Foundations lessons we studied the work of the Holy Spirit.

**English:** We didn't not study double negatives and the consequences they bring if one was to use them in their writing (the classic body slam). We also picked out a Tall Tale from our writing files to give a dramatic presentation. Their weekend assignment is to prepare the dramatic presentation for Monday. The students should be practicing this many times in the mirror and in front of the family if possible.

**Reading: Bridge to Terabithia:** Grading for this unit is going to be a little different than in the past. For this book, the students are graded on their preparedness for discussion and their participation in the discussion. They will also have one quiz each week.

**Math:** The 5th graders had an investigation on displaying data. For this investigation, we used the Chromebooks to create different charts from Google Sheets. They also had lessons on reducing fractions, greatest common factors (GCF), properties of geometric solids, and how to calculate mean, median, mode, and range. The 6th graders also had an investigation. Theirs taught them how to bisect geometric constructions. They also had lessons on arithmetic with units of measure, how to calculate volume of a rectangular prism and proportions

**Social Studies:** Mr. Henning continued our discussion of South Asia. We looked at this are of the country as it is today. We also reviewed and tested on the chapter.

**Science:** Mr. Henning studied Geologic Time with the students as it is recorded by an evolutionists perspective. He then discussed it from a biblical perspective.
