Math: The 5th graders reviewed symmetry, tested, read and ordered decimal numbers through ten-thousand, and used percents to name part of a group. The 6th graders used proportions to solve percent problems, tested, worked through two-step equations and found the area of complex shapes.

Social Studies: The last few graded assignments probably didn't go as well as the students would have liked. There is only one more test left and it will be on the upcoming chapter. There are eight grade worksheets between now and the end of the school year, and there are zero more map tests for the rest of the year. Encourage your child to stay focused during class time.

Science: We are onto our last full chapter of the year, Electricity. There are four more work sheet assignments left in the school year and zero tests. There simply aren't enough days in the year to fit everything in :(
