## History

The Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Education Assistance Endowment Fund was established with a generous bequest from Mr. Bruce Panning. Additional funding was received from the Arlene Manthe estate. The fund is intended to provide educational assistance to members of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church who are attending eligible schools into perpetuity. Additional gifts to this fund will increase the assistance available.

#### **Deadline**

<u>Applications are due on September 30</u>. Applications may either be delivered to a member of the Planned Giving Committee or postmarked on or before that date and mailed to the committee's chairman:

The Planned Giving Committee will inform students of the estimated educational assistance by November 30. Checks will be made payable to the school and sent directly to the school registrar after it is determined the eligible student has returned to school for classes in January.

### **Eligibility Policies**

- Students must plan to be fulltime students for both semesters of the school year.
- If a student discontinues after beginning the second semester, neither the student nor parents will be expected to refund the grant.
- Educational assistance grants are available to members in good standing of Trinity Lutheran Church, Belle Plaine, at the time they apply through December 31 of the current school term.
- We make an exception to the membership rule for students who attend Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. When a member of Trinity attending Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary transfers membership to an area congregation as requested by the Seminary to enhance his education, he shall remain eligible for education assistance. Assistance is available only for years in which the student pays tuition at the Seminary.
- The Planned Giving Committee requests that recipients of this grant write a thank you note that can be shared anonymously with the congregation.

### **Martin Luther College Matching Grant**

Martin Luther College offers a dollar-for-dollar matching grant to its students when they receive a grant from their home congregation. Here is a link: MLC Congregational Partnership grants

To qualify for MLC's match, the congregation's assistance must be received by MLC during the summer, prior to the first semester. Trinity's tuition assistance is not available until the second semester. To address this:

- Students attending MLC can request that their second semester grant from Trinity be applied to the first semester of the next school year. In this way the grant meets the requirements for the match. When Trinity students enter their final year at MLC, they can still receive a grant to apply to the second semester of their final year, in addition to the matched grant the was applied to their first semester tuition.
- Seniors attending a WELS Lutheran high school or prep school can also request the grant for the second semester of their 12<sup>th</sup> grade year be applied to the first semester of their freshman year at MLC. In this way the grant meets the requirements for the match.

We suggest discussing this option with a member of the Planned Giving Committee.
